Special Track of Admission

Prerequisites

For applicants who earn a bachelor's degree

- 1) Admission requires a bachelor's degree with minimum GPA of 3.0 in microbiology, biological sciences, or related fields. The program opens an opportunity for prospective students from various backgrounds in science such as biochemistry, chemistry, biology, zoology, plant sciences, genetics, general sciences, chemical engineering, food technology, biotechnology, pharmacology, medical technology, public health, marine sciences, and environmental sciences.
- 2) Applicants must have an English score (TOEFL or IELTS or CU-TEP). The minimum English scores for admission to the program are 45 (CU-TEP), 4.0 (IELTS), 450 (TOEFL PBT), 133 (TOEFL CBT), and 45 (TOEFL iBT).
- 3) A background knowledge and coursework of microbiology and biochemistry are required.

*** All English scores will be expired 2 year after the test date. The submitted scores must be valid until the date of final decision announcement.

- 4) A Letter of Recommendation must be submitted to the Department of Microbiology (contacts: Dr. Sarisa Na Pombejra).

The following application materials are required and must be submitted online.

- Application
- A photo (not more than 6 months old)
- A copy of national ID card (for Thai students) or a copy of passport (for international students)
- A copy of official transcript (if the applicant earned a diploma or an associate degree followed by two-year bachelor's degree program, the transcripts from both academic levels will be required for the submission.)
- A copy of English score certificate (CU-TEP or TOEFL or IELTS)
- A letter of recommendation (email to Dr. Sarisa Na Pombejra)
